The Communication System Interoperability Project was started to develop a way for KDOT employees, Kansas Highway Patrol (KHP) Troopers, and other public safety personnel to communicate with each other during critical events on disparate radio systems. This effort involved the acquisition and installation of newer communications equipment technologies in the KDOT communications tower sites around the state.
