This project replaced the old z9 mainframe processor with a new z114 processor. The old z9 processor was in place over four years. Typically, processors are replaced or upgraded every three or four years to stay compliant with service life, maintenance contracts, etc. The mainframe processor provides mainframe computing capacity for numerous agencies in the state including the Departments of Revenue, Children and Families, Transportation, Labor, and Administration.
